



A quick guide on how to use the Data Library

Once you have logged into your new SIRCA account, you will see SIRCA's Data Library on the homescreen:




Click on the Data Library button to access SIRCA's extensive library of data sets, which are available to download in a .csv format.


The datasets are grouped up by categories, not by specific data providers. For example, below in Auditors, there are datasets available from both Morningstar (MS) and SIRCA.




To download a dataset, simply select the data you want and a folder will appear at the bottom of the screen where you can select and download files. Simply select the file you want and hit the blue download button:



You can also select multiple files to download at the same time. In the next example there are multiple years in the ASX Broker Trades. Select the year you would like:



Then select the month(s) you want, again hitting the blue Download button when ready to download the files and all of your selections will be downloaded. Please note if this does not work for you then it is probably because your browser has not permitted our queuing pop-up to operate. Simply adjust the pop-up settings in your browser to enable our pop-ups and simultaneous downloads should work.



If your research needs access to Australian Company Announcements then you will be pleased to learn that we have a new search service in Data Library which retains all of the flexible and fuzzy searching capabilities that make this resource so useful.. Simply enter your required search terms and our Data Library service will find all matches from our enormous collection of ASX Company Announcements stretching back to 1992.

Search for announcements by any of the criteria below. All of the input boxes are optional - leave them blank to match on any value.

ASX Codes: Search for multiple codes separated with commas, e.g. CBA,BHP

Headline contains text: See below for help on text matching (e.g. "corporate governance")

PDF content contains text: See below for help on text matching (e.g. governance NOT corporate)

Start Date: Start Time: Dates must be in YYYY-MM-DD format and times are in HH:MM:SS format

End Date: End Time:

Price sensitive announcements only Price insensitive announcements only

Primary Report Codes: [View available report codes](#) Search for announcements matching one or more Primary Report Codes, separated by commas, e.g. 07,11.

Sub Report Codes: Search for announcements matching one or more Sub Report Codes, separated by commas, e.g. 02001,02006,07002,11002

Headline and PDF content text matching supports more complex matching rules using the [Lucene format](#). Some examples of searches you can do include:

- Search for exact matches using double quotes, e.g. "corporate governance"
- All search terms are normally optional. Use + at the beginning of the term to make it mandatory, e.g. +corporate governance. This works with double quote terms as well, e.g. +"corporate governance".
- Search for a combination of terms using the AND command, e.g. "corporate governance" AND 2018
- Exclude certain terms using the NOT command, e.g. governance NOT corporate
- Fuzzy matching to include announcements with mistyped words, e.g. corporate~
- Using the ? character to match any letter, e.g. co?porate
- Using the * wildcard character to match any sequence of multiple letters, e.g. cor*te
- Search for cases where two words are located close together, e.g. "corporate governance">5 will include cases where 'corporate' and 'governance' are located up to 5 words away from each other
